SPECIAL RULES FOR BREEDING SWINE

1. In addition to these Special Rules, this department is subject to the General Rules and Regulations as stated in this Premium List.
2. **SCHEDULE OF EVENTS** – See [Swine – General & Health Rules](#).
3. **OWNERSHIP** – Animal must be bona fide property of and owned by the exhibitor by August 1, 2024, as recorded on registration certificate. Certificate must accompany animal to the EXPOSITION and be presented upon demand any time during the EXPOSITION. Original certificate of ownerships must accompany animal to the show. NO photo copies, fax copies, etc. will be accepted.
4. **ENTRY FEE** – See [Swine – General & Health Rules](#). A minimum of two and a maximum of three animals are allowed per pen, which may be used for breeding swine and barrows. A limited number of dividers are available. It is suggested that animals be penned together at home in order to meet the minimum number. However, Show Management has the right to create the maximum use of pens with no refunds. **Incomplete entries will not be accepted.**
5. **OUTSTANDING ACCOUNTS** – If monies are owed to the show for any reason, the premium checks will be held and exhibitors will not be allowed to participate in any Commonwealth- sponsored show until restitution is made of the outstanding accounts.
6. **SHOWING** – Each animal in the show ring must be accompanied by a showman.
7. **PREMIUMS** – All premiums are subject to change by the KILE Executive Committee dependent upon funding support.
8. **ENTRY LIMITS** – Individuals or firms are permitted to only enter and show two animals in any one class.
9. **SUBSTITUTION** – Substitutions within breed and within sex will be permitted and, if made, must be filed with the Superintendent no later than the time animals are checked in the EXPOSITION by the Show Committee.
10. **PENS** – Assignments will be made by Superintendent. No animals permitted in pens except those entered in the show.
11. **BEDDING** – Straw is the preferred choice of bedding by show management. Shavings or other types of bedding are allowed but must be removed from the pen before departure. Any pens not emptied and swept clean will be assessed \$50.00 per pen. Get final OK from management before departure. All beddings must be provided by exhibitor. Straw can be purchased at the feed room.
12. **IDENTIFICATION** – Evidence of fresh ear notches or a lack of ear notches will disqualify the animal. See special rules on identification on second page of this document.
13. **SLICK SHEARING** of animals is strongly discouraged.
14. **ARRIVAL TIMES** – See [Swine – General & Health Rules](#) for times.
15. **CHECK-IN** – Exhibitors must check in health papers with the Bureau of Animal Industry staff upon arrival. Exhibitor's entry acceptance letters will explain the health check-in procedure. Exhibitors must also check in all animals with registration papers with the breed clerks between 10:00 AM and 4:00 PM on Friday, September 28, 2024. Exhibitors whose animals are not checked in by 4:00 PM will not be eligible to show.
16. A committee representing Show Management will observe the handling of all animals, both in and out of the show ring, and will have the authority to disqualify any exhibitor for unethical practices.
17. **RELEASE TIME** – See [Swine – General & Health Rules](#).
18. **PREMIER EXHIBITOR SPECIAL AWARD** – Will be awarded in each breed to the exhibitor winning the most points in individual classes. Championships will not be included. Points will be granted as follows: 1st - 10 points; 2nd - 8 points; 3rd - 6 points; 4th - 4 points; 5th - 2 points; 6th and over - 1 point. 1 point to each additional entry in a class. In case of a tie, the award will be given to the exhibitor with the greater number of higher placing.
19. **TRAILER PARKING** – Trailers will be permitted to park on-site as space permits. Off-site parking is encouraged. See the [map](#) for parking directions.
20. **BERKSHIRE** – All Berkshire swine must be registered by the American Berkshire Association (ABA), 2637 Yeager Rd., West Lafayette, IN 47906. Said registration paper must be presented at time of check-in. The ABA is the only Berkshire swine registry recognized by the National Association of Swine Records (NASR) and the National Pedigreed Livestock Council (NPLC).
21. Classes of 30 head or more will be split at the discretion of Show Management by age, and payout will be based on the sliding scale of 15-plus head for each group.
22. **Maximum of 2 crossbred gilts are allowed per exhibitor. Each exhibitor must show at least one purebred gilt to be eligible to enter gilts in the crossbred show.**

IMPORTANT

"Use only grooming products that are approved for use on meat-producing animals when fitting any animal for show. Unapproved products may contain ingredients that result in unacceptable residues in the meat. If it is not certain that a product is residue safe and approved for use on meat animals, **do not use it!** ****Important!**** **If upon slaughter, treatment with drugs, biologics, or any chemical from fitting products is the cause of condemnation of a carcass, the loss of the carcass and any other damages will be borne by the exhibitor."**
